The angiotensin-converting enzyme, a candidate gene involved in hypertension, and a genetic polymorphism of the gene are reported in the literature. Published studies on the role of the ACE gene in hypertension, ischemic heart disease, and renal function in blacks are extremely heterogeneous, and there are no works on this issue in West Africa. Therefore, we have investigated the gene in two groups of black subjects: a group of Cameroonian people and a group of African Negroes. The ACE genotype, determined by RFLP analysis, was: I = 33%, II = 25%, and DD = 42% in the Cameroonians; I = 32%, II = 25%, and DD = 43% in the black African group. The allele distribution frequency (I and D) was 0.47 and 0.53 for the Cameroonians and 0.46 and 0.54 for the black Africans. The allele frequencies in the two groups were in Hardy-Weinberg equilibrium. In the Cameroonians, the frequencies of DD and I/D heterozygotes were significantly higher in hypertensives and patients with ischemic heart disease than in normotensives and normocardics. We concluded that the ACE gene polymorphism is not involved in the pathogenesis of hypertension and ischemic heart disease in the black subjects studied. Moreover, the two black subjects groups studied have similar allele and genotype distributions.
