Category:Pro Evolution SoccerKapunda The Kapunda region of South Australia is a semi-arid zone and part of the Adelaide Plains. It lies between the Gawler Ranges to the northwest and the Mount Lofty Ranges to the southeast, and has a population of approximately 38,000 people. History The Kapunda area is known to have been occupied by Indigenous Australians for at least 7000 years and was the home of the Wakandak and Ngarrindjeri Aboriginal peoples. The Waite/Apunipima and Wiriyatjara Aboriginal peoples also held traditional land tenure rights in the area, although the latter had been displaced by the mid-nineteenth century, and have since moved to the west. In 1862, gold was discovered in the area by William Blandowski, and was later discovered by Charles Maree at Kapunda Drift in 1860. The town of Kapunda was established in 1869, and on 29 June 1875, J. Crawford was issued with the first mining licence in the district. The town soon grew into a successful mining town, and was proclaimed a town in 1883. The Kapunda Tramway was opened in 1882, connecting it to the city of Adelaide, and was the first such line to be built in South Australia. The main street of the town is still known as Tramway Way, as the name was applied to an access road from the railway in 1876, after which many businesses moved onto the street. The town's success continued, and by 1890, it was granted municipal status and had a population of 1,701. The township's population grew steadily through the late 19th and early 20th centuries, but was hampered in the 1930s by poor rainfall, and never grew large enough to give it the status of a city. The mining industry declined in the 1940s, and by the mid-1960s was only a small regional town, with about 8,000 people living within the Kapunda and Enfield District Council. The mining activity continued, however, and was one of the main industries for the area until 1977. After 1977, mines and towns in the same 82138339de
