Joseph Lieberman (I-Conn.) delivered a blistering criticism of the Obama administration on Monday, telling NBC News' Andrea Mitchell that Obama cannot be trusted when it comes to an issue that strikes at the heart of American democracy: voting rights. "I think the basic structure of our democracy and our institutions are seriously at risk," Lieberman told Mitchell. "If President Obama doesn't do more to defend core institutions of our democracy, the rule of law, first and foremost the rule of law." Lieberman then returned to a subject he has long been passionate about: registration and voting. On Monday, he again suggested that Tuesday's election, which will be decided by just 13 electoral college votes in four key states, is a referendum on the next president. As chairman of the Armed Services Committee in the late 1990s, Lieberman led an investigation into the 2000 election fiasco, which he said was one of the worst he's ever seen. "We set a goal for ourselves this morning and that is: Can we double in five years the number of people participating in our democratic process?" he said. "If we can do that, we will have put into place for the next hundred years a barrier to domination of American politics by billionaires." Lieberman also took issue with Obama's suggestion that the Supreme Court, which will hear the case on behalf of the state's officials at Tuesday's election, "spent most of its time" on the Shelby decision,
